Person-centered Job Selection / Career Profile / Vocational Profile - A process of learning about a job seeker, so that the information may be translated into job tasks, settings, preferences, and support needs which will become the basis for creating a targeted job development list. Person-Centered Job Selection concludes with the development of a Person-Centered Employment Plan (PCEP) with traditional supported employment, a Career Profile with IPS supported employment, or a Vocational Profile with customized employment.

Job Development/ Job Development Services with Job Acquisition Report - The process of creating employment opportunities and securing competitive integrated employment. This includes networking with and learning about businesses to help identify potential positions, that match what was identified in the Person-Centered Employment Plan, Career Profile, or Vocational Profile as closely as possible, and aid in the application process. The goal is to match the skills, abilities, and interests of individuals with the work needs of the employer, either through open or negotiated positions. It includes the development of a job acquisition report with IPS supported employment.

Job Acquisition with Support and Stabilization/ Supported Employment Services - Direct on-the-job support to help the person reach their highest level of competence at performing job tasks and successfully integrating into the workplace culture. Previously referred to as 30-,60-, and 90-day outcomes in the OVR system.

Long-term Employment Supports/ Extended Services - Direct or indirect support or monitoring to help the person maintain their employment and consider opportunities for career advancement. Content of the specific long-term supports are defined in the current Long-Term Employment Support Plan or OVR Extended Service Plan if this is the first long-term support request following OVR funding. Commonly referred to as Extended Services in the OVR system.

Assistive Technology (1915(i) RISE only): Includes low tech to high tech devices, solutions, or equipment. Also includes needs assessments, the exploration of alternatives, assistance with selection of technology, individual and small group training, maintenance and repair, and one-time implementation training.

IPS Supported Education (1915(i) RISE only): Includes assistance to engage and navigate the learning environment; support and enhance attitude and motivation; develop skills to improve educational competencies, including social skills, social-emotional learning skills, literacy, study skills, and time management; promote self-advocacy, self-efficacy, and empowerment, including disclosure, reasonable accommodations, and advancing educational opportunities; and build community connections and natural supports as needed to adapt to and thrive within the educational program or setting of the individuals choosing.
