What style of communication works best for you (phone, written, text, or face-to-face)?

Do you feel like a respected and involved partner on your son or daughter's IEP team (Admissions & Release Committee)?

Have your son or daughter been referred to any service agencies that provide supports for adults? If so, what agency?

Is your son or daughter currently receiving SSI or SSDI? If so, what questions or concerns do you have about those benefits as they relate to employment?

Section 3: Focusing on Employment

What are your expectations for you son or daughter's employment?

What would make you feel comfortable about your son or daughter's employment future?

What activities does your son or daughter do at home that builds responsibility?

In what community do you see your son or daughter living as an adult?

What types of jobs do you think your son or daughter would enjoy based on their skills and interests?

Are there any local businesses where you think your son or daughter would enjoy employment?

Do you know any business owners in your community that you could contact for a potential work experience for your son or daughter?
